Consolidation point – UK

Customs Clearance

We require either Commercial invoices or ATA Carnets to undertake clearance on your behalf.

Separate Commercial Invoices should be made out for temporary import and for permanent import goods (literature/give-aways). Please see the attached example. Please fax a copy invoice to us for checking, and supply 3 originals with the shipment. Invoices should be typed and on company headed notepaper, signed, dated and stamped.

ATA Carnets should be used in the following circumstances:

1. High value consignment (Over £20,000.00)
2. Goods will be going onto another exhibition
3. Goods remain in the country for an extended period after the show

We can arrange ATA Carnets and indemnity/bonds on your behalf. Small quantities of literature associated with the product under the ATA Carnet do not require additional documentation.

Packing

We strongly recommend that all freight be packed into plastic or metal crates or cases.

All cases/cartons/pallets should be marked with the following:

Case number (1 of 3, 2 of 3 etc)
Name of exhibitor
Stand Number/ Hall Number
Name of show
Destination

Quarantine/ Fumigation

Important: wooden and straw packing are subject to the quarantine regulations, unless accompanied by a treatment certificate. We advise exhibitors to use only metal, plastic, cardboard or fabric packing materials as goods arriving without certificates will be fined and fumigated, which could result in a delay delivering goods to the show.

Excise Goods

Please do not ship any foodstuffs, beverages, alcohol or plants to the exhibition. All such items can be purchased locally.

The items listed above will only cause delays in customs clearance as a special certification and procedures must be observed.

Return Goods

During the show, a Meritex Representative will contact you on the stand to discuss the return shipment. Written instructions will be taken and a copy given to your site representative.

Insurance

We strongly advise that you cover your consignment under an all risks policy. Meritex can arrange the cover for you if required for an additional charge.

Terms of payment

Under our standard trading conditions, unless credit terms have been agreed in advance, invoices are payable immediately upon uplift of goods. Return consignments will only be released upon full settlement of account.
